## **Call for Abstracts**

We invite authors to submit abstracts for oral (25min for presentation, 5min for questions, totally: 30min) or poster presentation at the ENDA 2013 Congress in Zurich (Switzerland).

#### **Submission Guidelines:**

- 1. Abstracts must be submitted in English, German or French language.
- 2. Abstracts can be submitted in one of the following categories:
  - A) New models of management
  - B) Good clinical practice
  - C) "Interdisciplinarity"
  - D) Safe care
  - E) Measurement of leadership
- 3. The maximum length of an abstract is 1,000 characters (including spaces).
- 4. No more than one abstract will be accepted per participant.
- 5. All abstracts must be submitted until April 15, 2013 at the latest.
- 6. All abstracts must be submitted online via www.enda2013.org.
- 7. Abstract submitters need to be registered to the congress after their abstract has been accepted. Successful submitters will receive a voucher code (discount of CHF 200) for the registration fee.

All abstracts will be reviewed and evaluated by members of the Scientific Committee. Final decisions will be made by May 31st, 2013. By submitting your abstract you allow the congress organizers to publish your abstract in electronic and/or paper format, once your abstract has been accepted. There is no right of your submitted abstract being accepted or published by the organizers.
